Agenda 2: Review/record on achievements and outcomes of the Plan of Action for the AY:2022-23.

Action Taken Report (AY: 2022-2023)

PROGRAM MANAGEMENT CELL

Social/Rural Internship (Social Outreach Program)

As planned, a field immersion-based course titled 'Social/Rural Internship' was included in the curriculum for batch 2022-24 (AY 2022-23). As part of this course, students were sent to villages to familiarize themselves with the socio-economic environment of rural areas. The social/rural internship titled 'Social Outreach Program' (SOP) was executed on December 28-29, 2022, in identified villages of adjoining districts.

Field Immersion program

As planned, a field immersion program (linked with a few elective courses) was rolled out during the 4th term in AY 2022-23 for batch 2021-23 students. Based on the thrust areas of students, students are attached to participating organizations from the following sectors :

- Industry and Business (Small and Medium Enterprises & Start-ups)
- Plan for improving Academic Processes: In line with the plan, the following initiatives were taken during AY 2022-23 to improve the academic processes of the institute:
- A workshop was conducted by Dean (Academics) for faculty members for Outcome-based education (OBE).
- Dean (Academics) studied the reputed books on effective teaching and learning methods authored by Elizabeth F. Barkley, Patricia K. Cross, Trudy W. Banta, Bruce M. Mackh, and George W. Kuh. He then

conducted a session for faculty members to sensitize them about effective pedagogical tools (PT) and learning assessment tools(LAT).

- The faculty was motivated to introduce innovative methods of assessment/pedagogical interventions/student engagement in their course deliveries and document their experiences.
- Collecting students' feedback on courses is a regular practice at the institute. The institute has recently initiated the system of submission of the Action Taken Report by the concerned faculty member on the mid-term feedback. This captures the future actions faculty members plan to take to address the unfavorable feedback points.
- Faculty Development Program
- Faculty are encouraged to pursue the relevant course/FDPs for upskilling. During the year, a session on the Usage of ChatGPT was conducted by Prof Ankit Mehrotra for the faculty members.

RESEARCH AND PUBLICATION

To develop more institutional linkages

The Dean Research has been promoting research activities and research publications. Many faculty members actively involved in research and were publishing in Scopus, Web of science & UGC listed journals. There are 43 papers in total, 30 of which have been published and 13 have been accepted along with two book chapters.

CAREER MANAGEMENT CELL

Corporate Outreach & Connect:

- A total of 94 companies were visited in 3 cities for corporate outreach. In addition a total of 40 online empanelment meetings were also conducted with corporate. In addition the team visited a conclave organised by Retail Association of India
- A team of **2 students went to Hyderabad to meet 5 companies**, one of which got converted into a placement offer in Berkedia
- On 1st October 2022, SIP Mentor meet was organised to felicitate the contribution of Summer Internship Industry Mentors during SIP of 2021-23 Batch in Hybrid mode (Online & Offline). A total of 8 Corporate SIP mentors joined in online mode & 10 were in offline mode.

Training:

- Various training activities like Company Specific training, Mock PI, JD Specific and group discussion were conducted during AY 2022-23.
- Mock PI by 24 industry guests and 9 industry guests conducted GD on 10th Sep 2022.
- KGF – Know, Grow, Flow - Powerful Self Pitch, The Right Connect, Case-study, Group Discussion, About Yourself
- Company Specific trainings were done. Industry guests were invited from various sectors / job roles for the same, a total of 200 hours of training was conducted under this.
- Sankalp - SIP Workshop was conducted for the batch of 2022-24 to train them on various aspects related to SIP functionality within a company and evaluation pattern.
- Aptitude Training - External Resource, a freelance trainer was hired for the training. Total 35 classes for each section was conducted, with multiple Mock test through Moodle

IDP - Individual Development Program:

For evaluation, an assessment named as KASH was conducted on 10th Dec 2022, 37 industry guests had one-to-one interaction with 10 students each.
